



THE ABOVE LISTED AGENCIES OR DEPARTMENTS SHALL BE NOTIFIED A MINIMUM OF ONE (1) WORKING DAY IN ADVANCE OF THE CONTRACTOR CONDUCTING WORK THAT WILL HAVE AN IMPACT ON THE TRAVEL ROUTES OR RESPONSE ROUTES.
- 7. ALL NECESSARY PERMITS SHALL BE OBTAINED PRIOR TO THE COMMENCEMENT OF WORK
- 8. ALL WORK WITHIN THE N.Y.S. RIGHT-OF-WAY (ROW), AS SHOWN ON THE PLANS, SHALL CONFORM TO THE NYSDOT STANDARD SPECIFICATION, STANDARD DETAILS, AND PERMITS, OR AS ORDERED BY THE NYSDOT REPRESENTATIVE.
