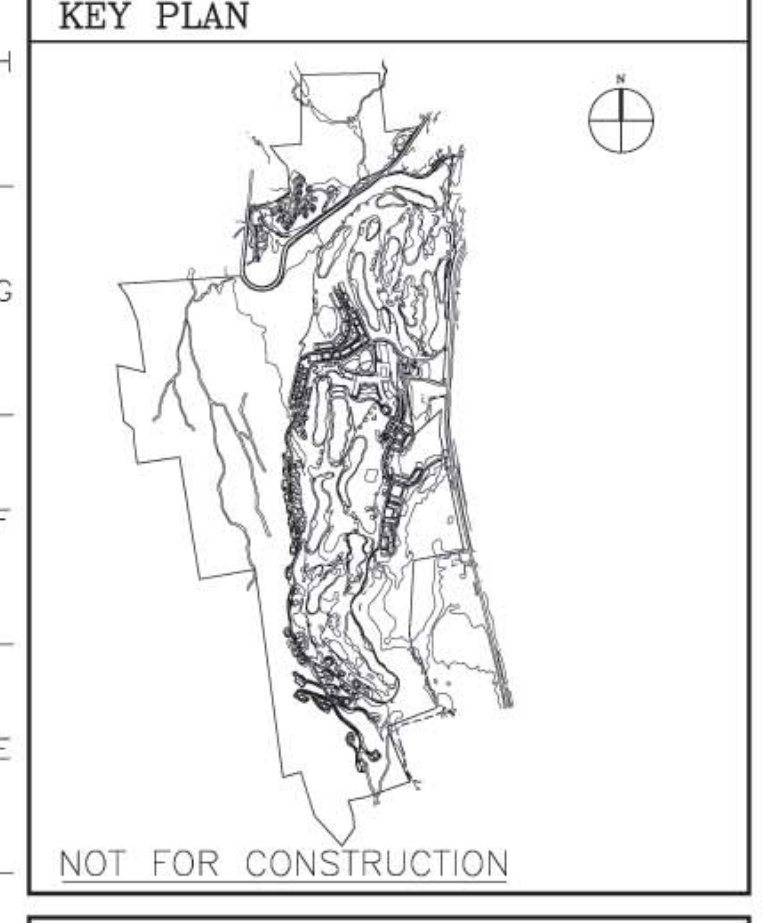

Lighting

The lighting scheme will be as minimal as possible while still providing a safe, comfortable environment. Pole lights and building-mounted fixtures will be traditional in character. The poles will be no more than 12-15' high to preserve a pedestrian scale. The most intense lighting will be concentrated in the Village Center, with street lights placed approximately 50-60' on center and periodically along paths in the Village Green. Secondary streets will be lit as necessary for safety, and outlying streets will remain unlit, in keeping with their more rural character.
